



## Overview of the 2015 & 2016 SNAAP Aggregate Frequency Report

SNAAP is an online survey, data management and institutional improvement system designed to enhance the impact of arts-school education. Since its beginning in 2008, arts alumni from participating educational institutions in North America have taken the opportunity to describe their educational experiences and career paths by answering the SNAAP questionnaire.

This report contains the response frequencies for all arts alumni who graduated from the high schools, undergraduate, and graduate institutions that participated in SNAAP in Fall 2015 and Fall 2016. Descriptive data about the alumni responding to the SNAAP questionnaire can be found in the Respondent Characteristics section on pages 6-11. The remainder of the report is divided according to the topical areas of the SNAAP questionnaire. Included in the report is the count or total numbers of alumni responding to each question at each level as well as the counts and percentages of alumni selecting each of the possible response options.
