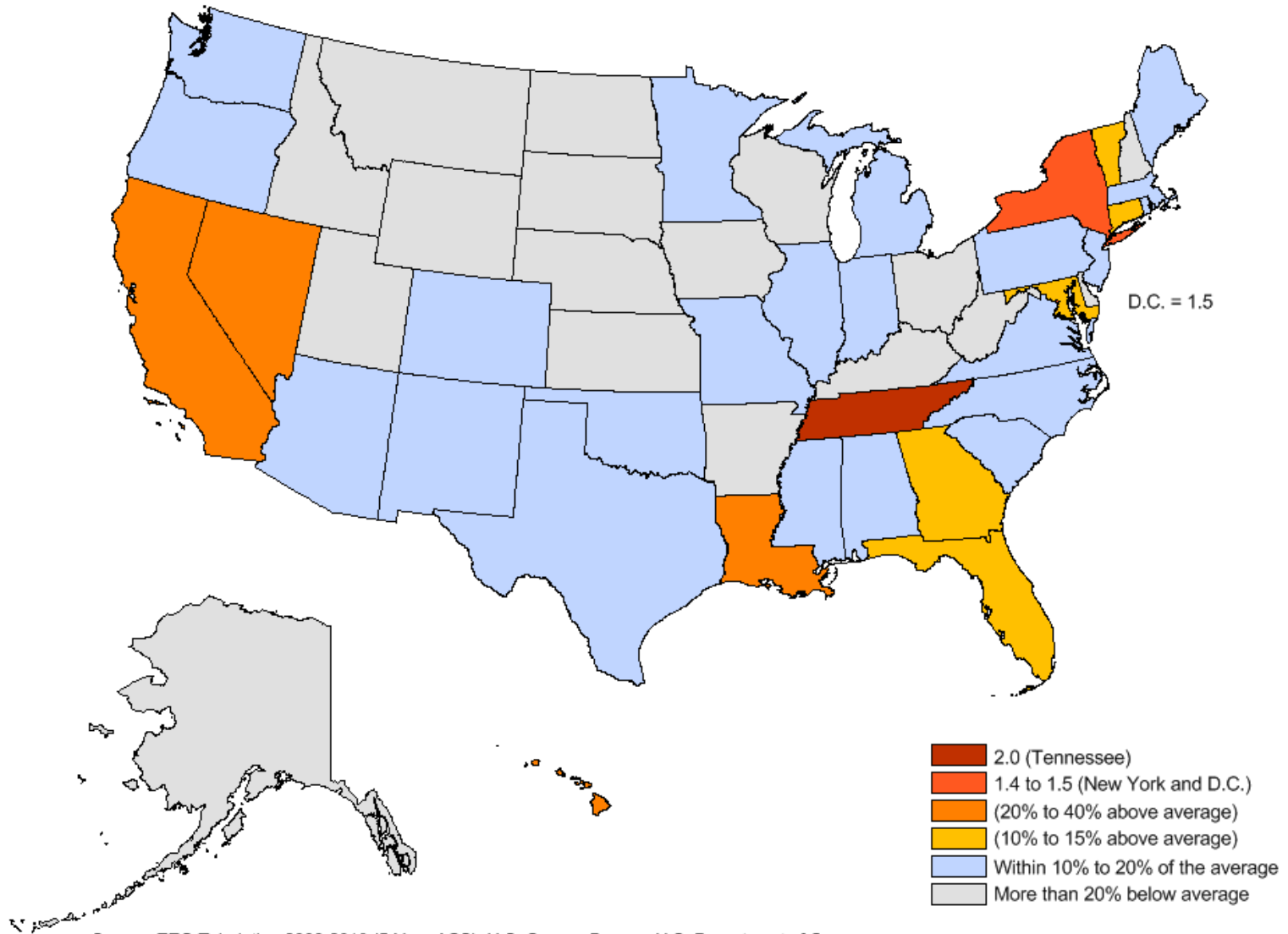
# EEO Tabulations

- Historically done on a 10-year basis
- Draws on the 2006-2010 ACS
- 487 detailed occupations
- U.S., states, metro areas, counties, “places” (i.e., cities and towns)
- Race/ethnicity; age groups; sex; industry; earnings; educational attainment

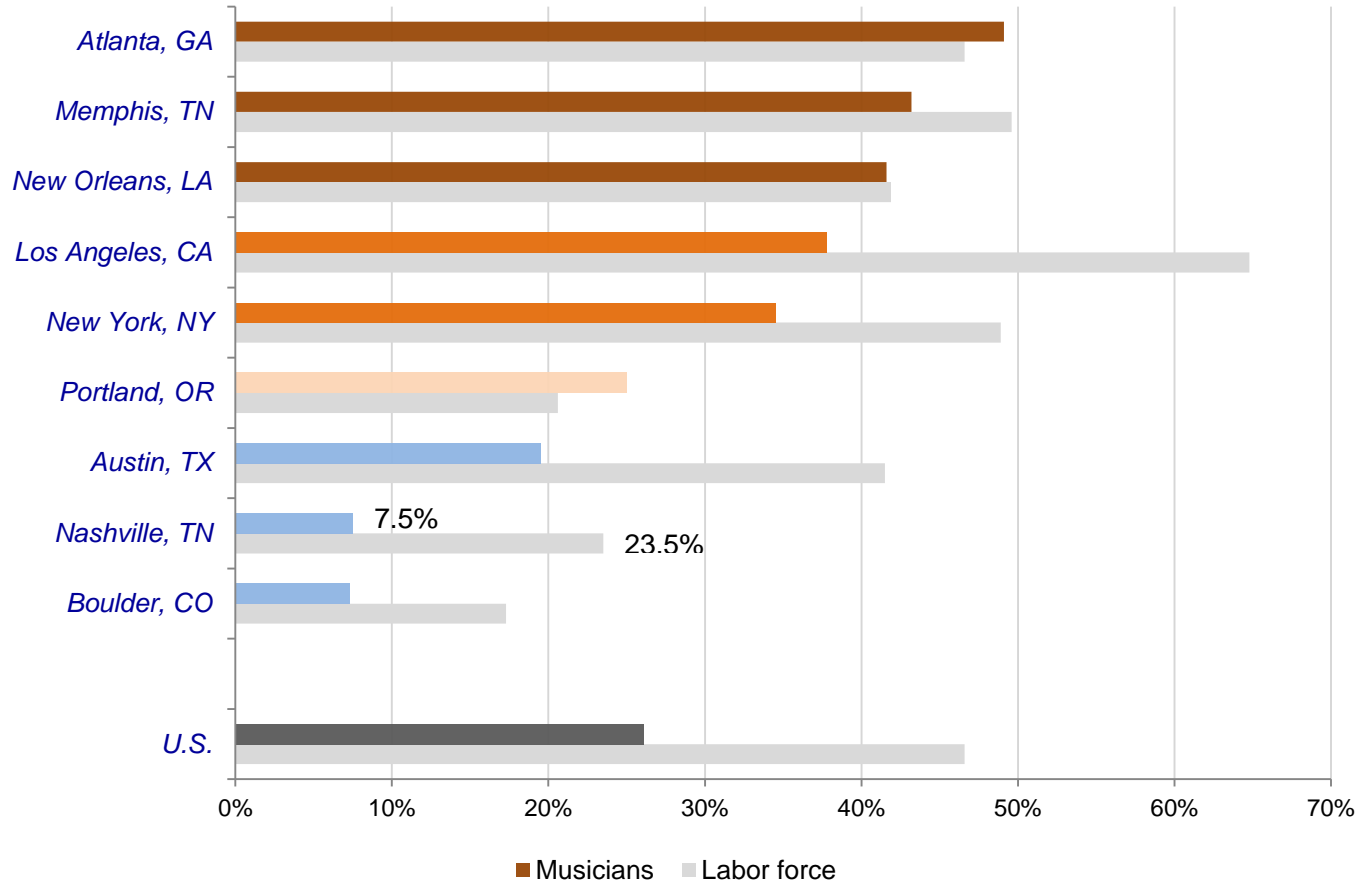

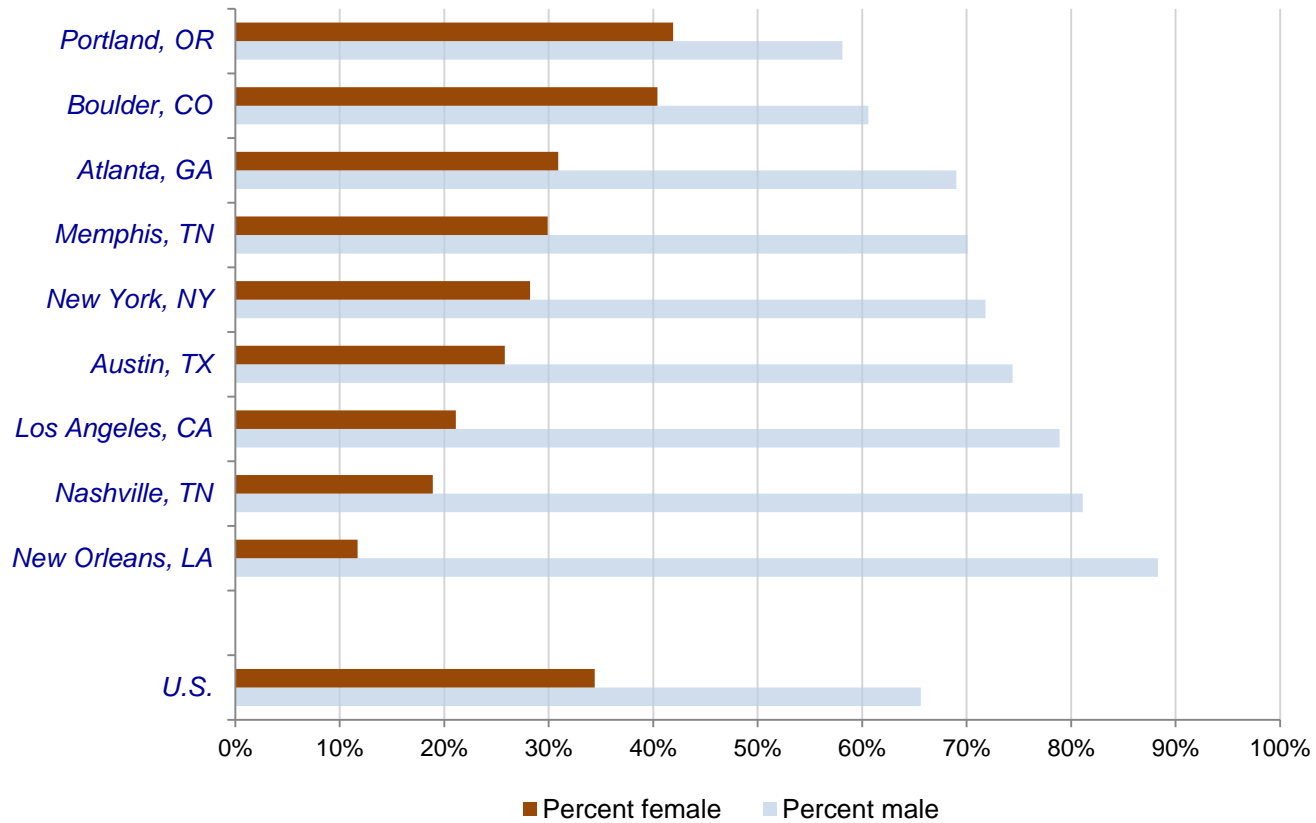
### Musicians, Percent Non-White: 2006-2010

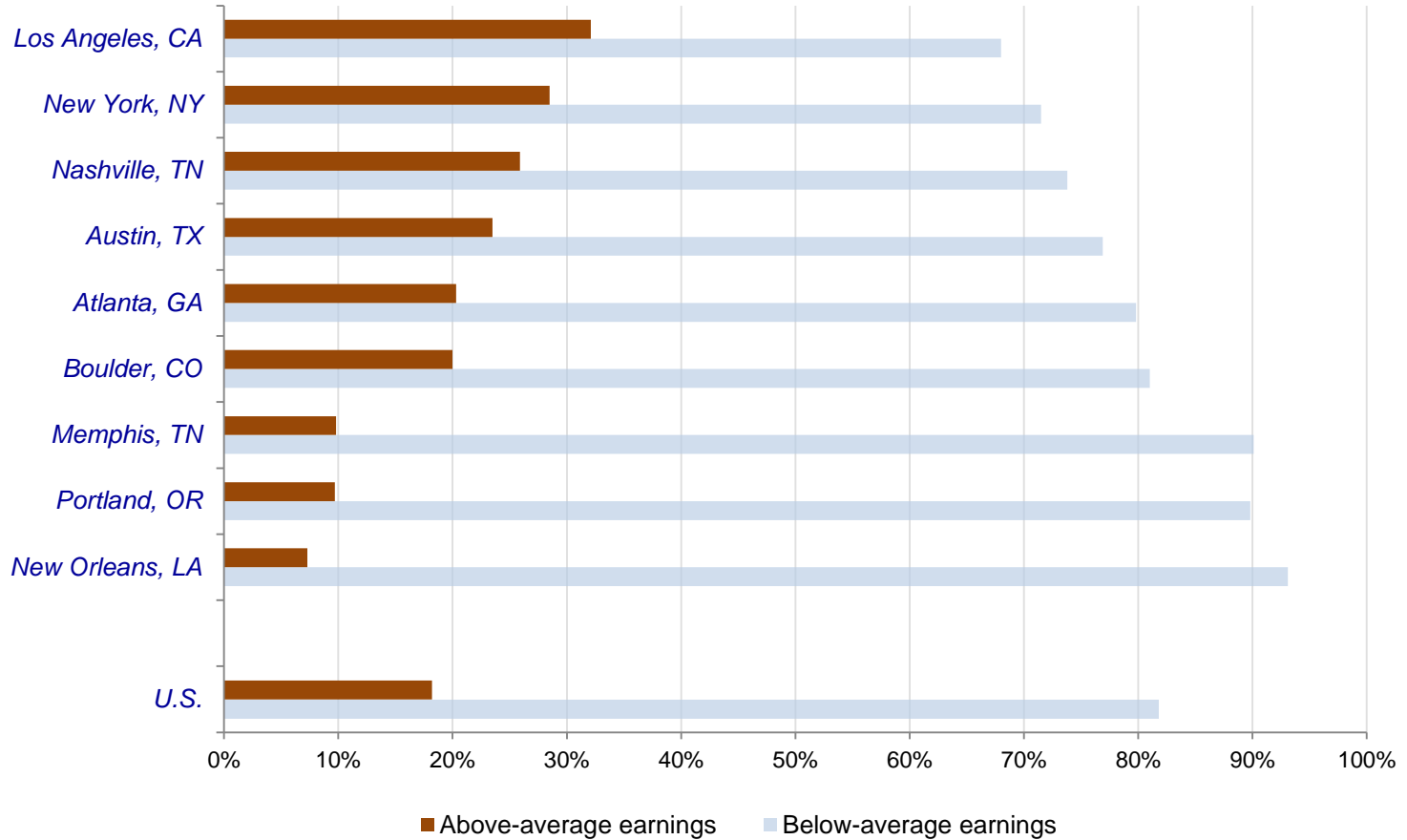
## Musicians by Gender: 2006-2010



Civilian labor force, 16 years and over

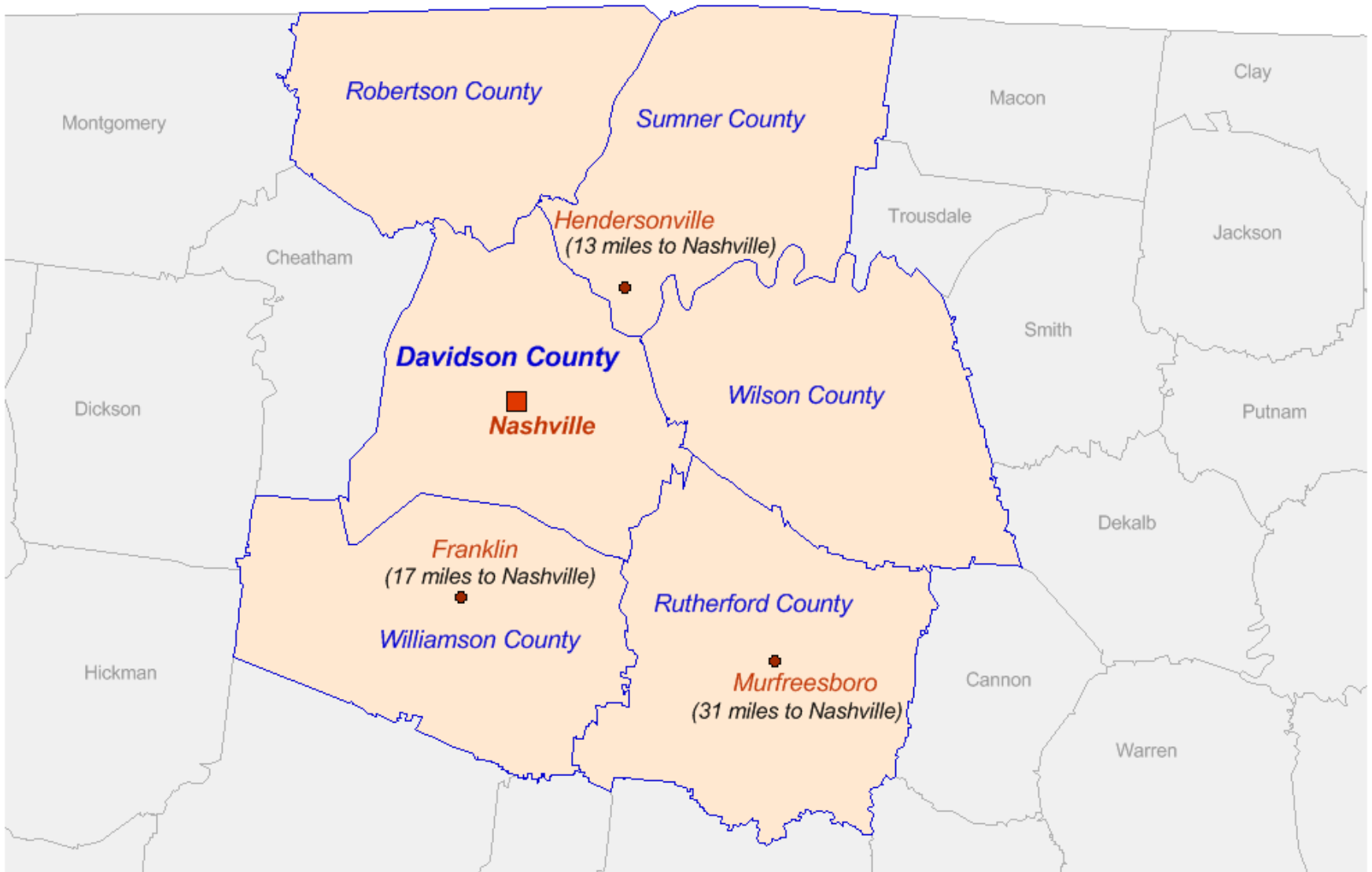

# Arts and Cultural Production Satellite Account (ACPSA)

- The ACPSA will provide detailed information on a select group of arts and cultural goods, services, and industries that are currently reflected in the GDP
- The ACPSA will provide a detailed accounting of the economic contribution of that sector

# What Products will the ACPSA Provide?

- Estimates of annual direct and indirect output (i.e., revenue and expenditures) by detailed ACPSA industries
- Direct and indirect employment within these industries
- Compensation within these industries
- Value added to GDP within these industries
